



Expectations of Road Captains/Group Leaders

- **Ride your own ride.**

Do not ride faster than you are comfortable with. Do not ride above your ability.

- **Obey all traffic signals and signs.**

When approaching a stop sign, make a full stop. This short pause will not only allow you to make sure that there is no oncoming traffic, but it will also allow the remainder of the group to catch up.

Once you make the turn, adjust your acceleration so that the rest of the group can keep up without having to use excessive speed to catch up.

- **Be aware of traffic around you.**

Remind your group to allow space between the bikes (and the groups themselves), to allow vehicles to come over as necessary.

- **Lead the ride according to the abilities of the least experienced rider.**

Always be aware of the least experienced rider in the group, know their skill level

And plan accordingly.

- **Avoid all U-turns unless absolutely necessary.**
- **Do not forget to review the hand signals before every ride.**

Do not assume that all riders in the group have a CB and/or they are familiar with the hand signals and their meanings.

- **Observe the posted speed limit at all times.**
